

Printing requirements

File format:

- Corel Draw up to X7
- Adobe Illustrator up to CS3
- pdf for printing
- eps

Bleeds:

- 1,5 mm on each side

Fonts:

- changed into curves

Colors:

- CMYK (optimal) or RGB

Graphic resolution:

- 300 or 600 DPI

Cut line:

- marked as red color
- sharp edges have to be rounded due to epoxy resin requirements, optimal 2mm radius

Logotypes projects should be vectorized to obtain best print resolution. Important ! Bitmap imported into vector programs such as: Corel or Illustrator is NOT a vector graphic.

In case you don't have file in vectors, it could be bitmap rasterized file. But then, the artwork should be prepared in CMYK colours and in proper resolution, keeping 1:1 scale; In case of 4 colour print 300 dpi and in case of black and white print 600 dpi. All texts should be changed into curves.

Before production we suggest to make a sample (paid). In case there is no sample production we do not accept any complaints concerning colours.
